FROM THE DEAN'S DESK

2008 continues to bring more good news for the Campaign. English Heritage have announced further funding for Rochester Cathedral – this time to fund a vital 'behind-the-scenes' project to commission a digital survey of the cathedral. They have granted £42,000 towards this project (total cost of £77,000), which will provide detailed survey drawings of critical areas of the cathedral. This will allow us to plan future repair and conservation work with much greater care and precision, and will ultimately save us money in doing so!

We were also delighted to hear that the HR Pratt Boorman Family Foundation have given us £10,000 to endow a day of music in perpetuity. This now takes the music endowment up to £1/4million, which is a good achievement in a notoriously difficult area to raise money. We hope that the Endow A Day Of Music scheme will continue to grow in popularity, as people consider leaving a bequest in their will.

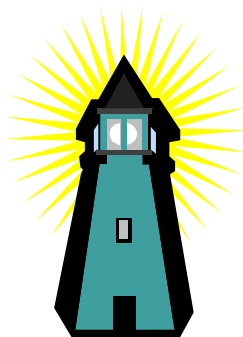
AN EVENING WITH THE GODSALLS

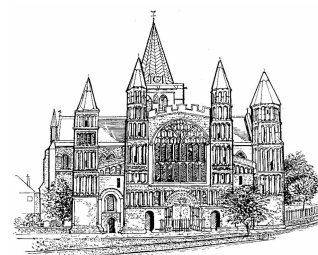
We will hold the event at the Baptist Hall in Crow Lane on Thursday 13th March 2008. Only a few tickets left!!

BITS AND PIECES ...

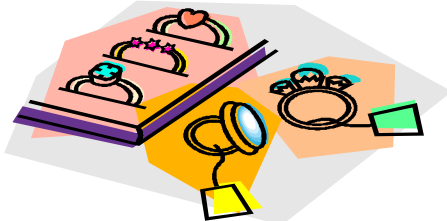
- *Other areas of work are bubbling away well. We are looking forward to the inaugural dinner of the Cathedral Business Guild on 6 March, with over 70 people coming.*
